Your Physician has recommended the Arterial Health Diagnostic Test Package - so naturally, you need to understand why these tests are important!

Why is my doctor recommending these tests?

Heart disease is the Number One killer In America. National health organizations estimate that 1 in 3 adults are at risk for cardio-vascular disease. The Arterial Health Tests are recommended for anyone at risk for stroke or heart attack due to physical attributes, age, lifestyle patterns, genetic or family history. You may have visible risk indicators or you may not - but over forty-percent of heart attacks occur without warning, without prior symptoms - meaning there are unseen, unknown conditions within a person's cardio-vascular system that could be fatal if not detected and treated.

What exactly will be done?

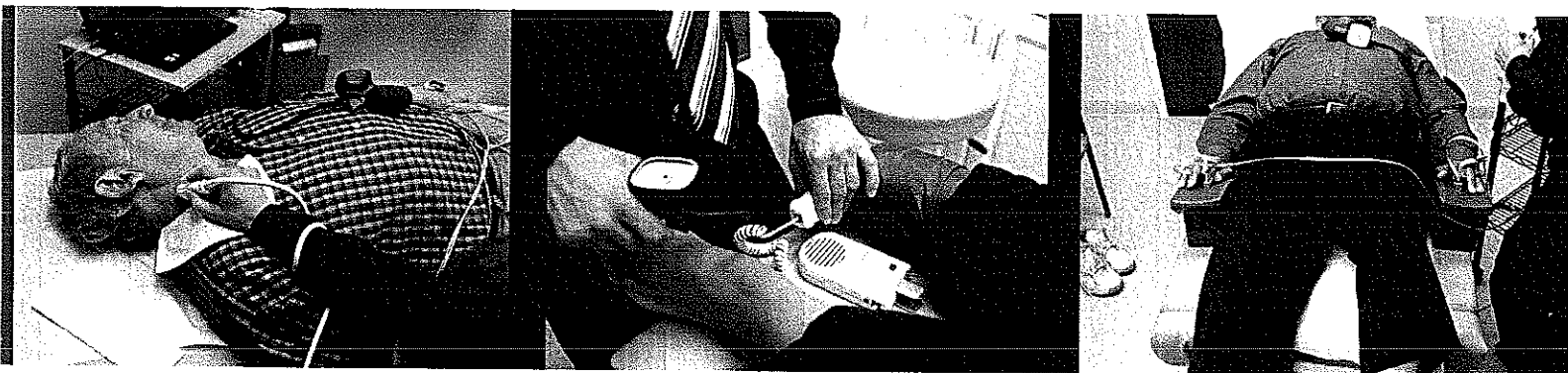
There are 4 distinct scans performed, each targeting specific parts of the artery system. The tests are computer-driven, but use simple equipment such as a blood pressure cuff on the arm and fingertip blood-sensing applicators like those you may have seen. Two of the tests use a standard ultrasound device. All you have to do is lie quietly on the table. Some patients even take a short nap!

How long will this appointment take?

The tests are performed within a 45 minute appointment.

What will it cost? What do I have to pay?

The tests qualify for insurance reimbursement, including Medicare and private pay, as well as reimbursement



But, I'm already doing/just had an EKG and stress test.

These tests go well beyond current technology used in traditional EKG or stress tests. Those focus solely on the heart, while these look into the health and well-being of the entire artery system. Blood clots, artery blockage (atherosclerosis), aneurysms (weakened artery walls) are all potentially fatal and all occur in the circulatory system. Current revelations in the cardiovascular field have shown that good arterial health is critical to early prevention of conditions that can lead to heart attack or stroke.
